A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE OFFICIAL INTENT AND REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHVILLE ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE BORROWER) TO REIMBURSE ITS FUND FOR THE CQ02AA, BREMEN AVENUE, MAIN STREET, AND ALLEY PAVING WITH THE PROCEEDS OF TAX EXEMPT DEBT OF THE STATE OF OHIO.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Rushville on behalf of the State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Village of Rushville reasonably expects to receive a reimbursement for the Project named Bremen Avenue, Main Street, and Alley Paving as set forth in Appendix A of the Project Agreement with the proceeds of bonds to be issued by the State of Ohio.

Section 2. The maximum aggregate principal amount of bonds, other than for costs of issuance, expected to be issued by the State of Ohio for reimbursement to the local subdivision is \$44,000.00.

Section 3, The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Rushville is hereby directed to file a copy of this Resolution with the Village of Rushville for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein and to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission

Section 4. The Village of Rushville finds and determines that all formal actions of this Village concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Village of Rushville and that all deliberations of this Village and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
