**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SEWER RATES AND  
TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 10-2022**

WHEREAS, the Village of Rushville has an aging sewer system, and

WHEREAS, this is resulting in additional labor and, and therefore, increased labor costs, and repair and replacement parts

WHEREAS, the Village of Rushville is required to provide and maintain the sewer system for all households and businesses connected to the system rates must be adjusted to provide the necessary funds to maintain proper operations of the system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Rushville, Fairfield County, Ohio.

SECTION I. That the following rate structure shall be adopted, and remain in effect, until such time as a review by the Council of the Village of Rushville deems it necessary to change rates to permit sufficient revenue to cover Operations and Maintenance portion of such billings




