**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH WATER AND WATER DEBT RATES AND
TO ABOLISH ORDINANCE 15-2021**

Whereas, the Village of Rushville desires to establish a structure of rates for the water system due to contracted increases in rates from the Village of Bremen and current and future inflationary trends and to abolish those rates that were previously effective, this ordinance shall be declared an emergency and become effective upon signature of the Mayor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHVILLE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO

SECTION I. That the following rate structure shall be adopted, and remain in effect, until such time as a review by the Council of the Village of Rushville deems it necessary to change rates to permit sufficient revenue to the Debt and Operation and Maintenance portions of such billings. Water debt to remain same as prior ordinance.

Fairfield Union High School

For Calendar Year 2024	0-200,000 gallons	\$2,345.85

Fairfield Union Middle School

For Calendar Year 2024	0-200,000 gallons	\$2,345.85

	2001 and over	\$2.56 per 1000 gallons

Residential Customers

For Calendar Year 2024	0-2000 gallons	\$30.13
	2001 and over	\$3.73 per 1000 gallons

SECTION II. To assure that sufficient funding is available for both known and unknown periodic and emergency repair, maintenance, and replacement of major components of the water system distribution network \$100,000.00 will be maintained for this purpose, and annual rates adjusted to include this reserve.
