

ORDINANCE 4-2024

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR NOT TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the village of Rushville, Fairfield County, Ohio, has established the position of village administrator;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §735.271 requires the village administrator become a resident of the village within six months after his or her appointment by the mayor and confirmation by the legislative authority of the village, unless his or her residence outside the village is approved by ordinance;

WHEREAS, this council has determined that no compelling reason exists requiring the village administrator to reside within the village limits;

WHEREAS, this council has determined that the most qualified person to serve as village administrator may from time to time live outside the village limits, as does the existing village administrator;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, council adopts the following provisions:

Section 1: The village approves that the village administrator may reside outside the village of Rushville limits.

Section 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to an emergency necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the village, in that the village is required to have a village administrator and that the most qualified person for this position may from time to time live outside the village limits, and council finds no compelling reason exists requiring the village administrator to live within the village limits.

This ordinance shall take effect upon signing by the mayor.
