AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO PLACE A NOTICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OHIO REVISED CODE REQUESTING APPLICATIONS FOR VACANT MAINTENANCE WORKER POSITION

WHEREAS, Council desires to provide essential services to the Village residents in the event of a breakdown or failure of power at its waterworks and sanitary sewer ~~plant~~ and all other associated duties; and
SYSTEM

WHEREAS, to accomplish this goal, the Village requires three maintenance workers to perform such work; and

WHEREAS, the rate of pay shall be \$18 (Eighteen Dollars) per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHVILLE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council hereby directs the village clerk to place a Help Wanted advertisement in the local paper as well, as any relevant job search boards.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Rushville are involved and specifically to ensure prompt and adequate provision of potable water and sanitary sewer services, thereby preserving the sanitary wellbeing of the village. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.
