AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ASSIGNMENT OF MATTHEW LARUE AND WILLIAM MEYERS TO CO-VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council desires to provide essential services to the Village residents for water supply and sanitary sewer systems, as well as general Village property and systems

WHEREAS, to accomplish this goal, the Village requires Village Administrators to initiate and schedule work and purchase required parts to reach said goal.

WHEREAS, the Village does not have a Village Administrator, as required under Ohio Revised Code §735.271, which states, "The village administrator shall be appointed by the mayor, but shall not take office unless his appointment has been approved by a majority vote of the members elected to the legislative authority of the village."

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §735.273 provides, in pertinent part, "The village administrator appointed under section 735.271 of the Revised Code shall manage, conduct, and control the water works, ... or other similar public utilities, furnish supplies of water, ... and collect all water [and similar]... rents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHVILLE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council hereby directs the Mayor to appoint Matthew Larue and William Meyers to the position of Co-Village Administrators. The starting rate of pay shall be \$20.90/hour.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Rushville are involved and specifically to ensure prompt and adequate provision of potable water and sanitary sewer services, thereby preserving the sanitary well-being of the Village. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.
