**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND (2151) FOR THE YEAR 2023**

Whereas, the Village of Rushville is permitted, pursuant to the terms of the grant, to use these funds for sewer infrastructure improvements, and

Whereas, the Village of Rushville requires immediate improvements to its sewer infrastructure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village of Rushville, Fairfield County, State of Ohio, that an amendment be made to the previous appropriations made for the year 2023, as follows:

Section 1. \$10,720.98 available through the American Recovery Plan Act will be appropriated within the 2151 fund.


Section 2. Within the 2151 fund, the funds will be appropriated as follows:

2151-649-399 Other Contractual \$5,000
2151-549-400 Supplies and Materials \$5,720.98

Section 3. This Ordinance, being an appropriation for the expenses of the Village, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and signing by the Mayor.
